'I like reading. It is very hard for me to do it well and also to speak good English to people all over the world and be able to write messages to friends around the world but I try.'


♥ Daniel Kanu (boy), age 13, Sierra Leone

'I have promised myself that when I am educated this is the beautiful house I will build for myself.'







'I am in primary six. I am drawing my favorite flower for my lovely friends from far away.'








